Peter Learned that Jesus Is for All- Cornelius Calls for Peter (TheChurch Grows)

Bible Scripture - Adventure Bible Cornelius Calls for Peter Pg.1211

(Please read let your children know everything in Bible is true)

Based On-Acts 10:1-8

Christ Connection: God showed Peter the good news about Jesus is for everyone. God wants believers to tell everyone the good news about Jesus no matter who they are or what they do. Jesus is the Lord of all.

Scripture: Like a body has many parts, the church has many people who work together. (1 Corinthians 12:12)

Lesson Objective-Scripture is found in Acts 10:1-8- Cornelius calls for Peter

This week's Scripture begins in the town of Caesarea and a man named Cornelius. He was a commander in the Roman army. Cornelius' family gave money to the church. He and his family prayed to God regularly. Cornelius had a vision about three in the afternoon one day. He saw an angel of God. Cornelius was scared of the angel. Cornelius asked, " What is it Lord?" (Acts 10:4) The angel told him to send men to Joppa and bring Peter to Caesarea. When the angel left. Cornelius sent for a soldier and a servant. He told them everything that happened and sent them to Joppa. They went to get Peter.

Biblical Truth-Jesus is the Lord of all.
